## Description

This product is a neutral pH multi-surface cleaner, and deodorizer. This product is for non-scratch cleaning of showers and tubs, shower doors and curtains, fixtures, and toilet bowls. This product is for use on mildew stains in damp areas such as bathrooms, showers, kitchens, basements and laundry rooms. This product is for use with a mop and bucket, trigger sprayers, sponge, or by soaking. This product is specially formulated to effectively eliminate offensive odors caused by mold and mildew. This product provides effective cleaning strength that will not dull most metal-interlock floor finishes, and does not require a rinse prior to recoat. This product contains no phosphates or phosphorous compounds.

Cross-contamination is of major housekeeping concern not only in hospitals, but in schools, institutions, and industry. This product has been formulated to aid in the reduction of cross-contamination in these areas. When used as directed, big pine plus will deodorize surfaces in toilet areas, behind and under sinks and counters, garbage cans and garbage storage areas, and other places where bacterial growth can cause malodors.

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This product is not for use on medical device surfaces.

**Contact Time:** Leave surface wet for 1 minute [60 seconds] Use a 10 minute contact time for disinfection against all other viruses, bacteria and fungi claimed.

**Disposal of Infectious Material:** Blood, body fluids, cleaning materials and clothing must be autoclaved and disposed of according to local regulations for infectious waste disposal.

## FIRST AID

**IF SWALLOWED:** Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
