Acid Neutralizer is an environmentally friendly, cost-effective means of raising the pH of acidic washer discharge into waste streams. **Acid Neutralizer** is designed specifically for use in machine applications such as cart washers, cage and rack washers, washer-disinfectors, and holding tanks where acidic rinses are used.

Directions for Use

Acid Neutralizer should be dosed to sufficiently raise the pH of the solution to levels appropriate for the facility's Standard Operating Procedure. This is usually between pH 5 and 9. Consult your local municipality or sewer district for an acceptable waste-water pH range. Always follow machine manufacturers' instructions for use.

Safety

Always don proper Personal Protection Equipment (PPE) while using this product. DO NOT ADD BLEACH or any other chemical to **Acid Neutralizer** in a manner other than directed. Combining chemicals outside of the instructions for use could result in loss of efficacy or adverse chemical reactions. **Acid Neutralizer** is compatible with stainless steel, glassware, and most plastics.

Consult the Safety Data Sheet (SDS) for more detailed information pertaining to safety, handling, storage, and waste disposal methods.

Store detergent at temperatures below 120°F (49°C). The product is freeze/thaw stable. If frozen, thaw to room temp and shake or stir with drill mixer or similar. Once the container is empty, rinse, and dispose of properly. Do not reuse this container. Any waste should be disposed of according to Federal, State, and/or local regulations.
